

## Inpex goes public on gas

**Browse Basin gas field developer Inpex has started a series of public information displays around the Kimberley.**

Its intent is to inform people about the company's project and what impacts it will have on the various Kimberley towns.

Media from the East and West Kimberley were briefed at an evening function in Broome on Friday night.

Inpex intends to transport gas from the Ichthys deposit in the Browse Basin via a sub-sea pipeline to the Maret Islands.

It will develop an offshore semi-submersible central processing facility and a gas processing facility on the Maret Islands consisting of a 7.6 million tonnes per annum gas plant and export facility.

The Japanese-owned company has already gained initial support from the Kimberley Land Council and predictable opposition from Kimberley Environs, which staged a protest near the islands recently.
