

# NT Govt moves to guarantee land for Inpex plant

**The Northern Territory Chief Minister says legislation will be introduced into Parliament this week to provide a guarantee to gas company Inpex that their proposed LNG plant will be able to be built at Blaydin Point in Darwin Harbour.**

Paul Henderson says the legislation aims to provide certainty over land being available at Middle Point.

Mr Henderson says it is not a back-door way for the project to avoid environmental scrutiny.

"Inpex will be required to go through the full territory and commonwealth EIS process," he said.

"The legislation doesn't exclude them from that. It's really about the terms and conditions, what's available in terms of land at Middle Point."
