

Don't rush LNG site decision, Garrett urges Barnett

Federal Environment Minister Peter Garrett has warned the State Government against rushing its plan to develop an LNG precinct in the Kimberley.

Mr Garrett urged Colin Barnett to back the wider assessment process, which would also consider other areas.

The Premier is expected to nominate his preferred site tomorrow, prompting Mr Garrett to encourage "a co-operative approach".

Mr Barnett is considering two sites — North Head, about 125km north of Broome on the Dampier Peninsula, and James Price Point, about 60km north of Broome.
