**Question**

With regard to Burrup Fertilisers and the Fire and Emergency Services Authority (FESA), I ask –

- (1) How many times has FESA attended the Burrup Fertiliser Plant and/or associated infrastructure since the commissioning of the plant?
- (2) Will the Minister list the dates of these attendances?
- (3) Will the Minister list the reason for each attendance?

- (1) 6 times.
  - (2)(a) 12 June 2006
  - (b) 6 September 2006
  - (c) 24 October 2006
  - (d) 25 October 2006
  - (e) 14 November 2006
  - (f) 2 April 2007
- (3)(a) 12 June 2006 - Observe emergency preparedness arrangements and ammonia loading systems for the first shipment of ammonia from the Bulk Liquids Berth.
  - (b) 6 September 2006 - Observe performance of revised fire suppression monitors on the Bulk Liquids Berth.
  - (c) 24 October 2006 - Meeting to discuss performance criteria for upgrading of the Bulk Liquid Berth fire systems.
  - (d) 25 October 2006 - In conjunction with other State Government Agencies attended Burrup Fertilisers as part of a scheduled program (23-26 October 2006) to review special risk plans of industries located on the Burrup Peninsular.
  - (e) 14 November 2006 - Attended the Bulk Liquids Berth in response to a minor ammonia leak from the cooling system on an ammonia tanker ship.
  - (f) 2 April 2007 - To provide emergency management input into a system integration study.
