**Question**

With regard to question number 4454 and the condition 3 in the tabled letter Ref 11-8877 of 26 February 2007 to Lucio Della Martina, Director, Pluto (where it is not possible to comply with Condition 2, use best endeavours to record, salvage and relocate Sites, using the processes set out in conditions 5, 6, 7 and 8 below), and I ask -

(1) How will the site or sites be salvaged or relocated, given that the definition of a site is that it is a complex entity?

(2) How will the site or sites be salvaged or relocated, given the Burrup Peninsula is listed on the interim register as Site 23323?

**Answered on 13 November 2007**

The Department of Indigenous Affairs advises:

(1) Sites are defined in accordance with section 5 of the *Aboriginal Heritage Act 1972*.

(2) Cultural features recorded in association with site 23323 have been registered as individual sites and will be relocated accordingly.
