

Burrup air quality under review

AIR Quality on the Burrup Peninsula is the focus of an independent report by the CSIRO which has been welcomed by the WA Government.

The final Burrup Peninsula Air Pollution Study Report for the first year of air quality monitoring was presented to Resources Minister John Bowler by Burrup Rock Art Monitoring Committee president Frank Murray.

Mr Bowler said the data collected for the report was designed to compare air pollution levels in industrial areas with other areas on the Burrup and in remote but related base-line locations.
