

Environmental process begins for Kimberley gas fields

Woodside Energy is conducting an environmental approval process for its Browse Basin gas fields. (AFP)

Woodside Energy has begun the environmental approval process for the development of its Browse Basin gas fields in the Kimberley.

As operator of the Browse Joint Venture, Woodside wants to develop three gas fields in the Browse Basin.

Woodside has submitted to the Federal Government its proposal for the offshore component of the project.

The company's Annalisa Grubisher says plans for a Liquefied Natural Gas processing facility are still being developed.



"This is just one part of the approvals required for the development and we will be progressing separately the approvals required for the lng facilities," she said.

The proposal for the Browse Upstream Development has been submitted to the Commonwealth and is open for public comment until the third of April.
