



ASG wins contracts worth \$75m

Australia-based IT services provider ASG has won new and existing contracts with a total value of approximately \$75m from Dell Australia, Multiplex, Virgin Blue, Ericsson/Hatch, Inpex, and the West Australian Department of Corrective Services.

The vendor will provide IT support services to Dell Australia as part of its recent multimillion-dollar contract to provide new hardware to the Commonwealth Scientific and Industrial Research Organization. It will also provide project services to the WA Department of Corrective Services, and deliver Oracle applications and general IT support to Multiplex. In addition, it won a two-year contract to provide project services to LNG project developer Inpex.

The contract extension was with Ericsson/Hatch for provisioning its IT service management and Microsoft platforms.

Geoff Lewis, managing director at ASG, said: "Of the \$75m, about one-third is from additional services and extensions to existing contracts. This ongoing business has made a significant contribution to our growth and secured ASG's long-term annuity position in those chosen markets."
