

## **James Price Point will host WA LNG hub**

PERTH, AUSTRALIA: The Western Australian state government have selected James Price Point, 60 kilometres (37 miles) north of Broome as the site for a liquefied natural gas (LNG) hub along the Kimberley coast.

"James Price Point has been declared the location to most likely work best for the Kimberley community, for the environment, for industry and for Western Australia's future economic development," Western Australia Premier Colin Barnett told reporters in Perth.

The three other shortlisted sites were North Head, Gourdon Bay and Anjo Peninsula.

Barnett also claimed the government would acquire the required land for the LNG hub by force if representatives of Aboriginal communities rejected efforts to strike a deal to establish the plant on their traditional lands.
